- 1. Valid PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (Platinum Membership) (all pages)

- Technical Eligibility Documents

- 2. Duly notarized Secretary's Certificate attesting that the signatory is the duly authorized representative of the prospective bidder, and granted full power and authority to do, execute and perform any and all acts necessary and/or to represent the prospective bidder in the bidding, if the prospective bidder is a corporation, partnership, cooperative, or joint venture or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder. (sample form - Form No. 7).
 3. Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid, within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids. The statement shall include all information required in the sample form (Form No. 3).
 4. Statement of the prospective bidder identifying its Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. The statement shall include all information required in the sample form (Form No. 4).

Financial Eligibility Documents

5. The prospective bidder's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission.
 6. The prospective bidder's computation for its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) following the sample form (Form No. 5), or in the case of Procurement of Goods, a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NFCC computation.
- **Eligibility Documents – Class "B"**
7. Duly signed valid joint venture agreement (JVA), in case the joint venture is already in existence. In the absence of a JVA, duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful shall be included in the bid. Failure to enter into a joint venture in the event of a contract award shall be ground for the forfeiture of the bid security. Each partner of the joint venture shall submit its legal eligibility documents. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance, provided, that the partner responsible to submit the NFCC shall likewise submit the statement of all its ongoing contracts and Audited Financial Statements.
 8. For foreign bidders claiming by reason of their country's extension of reciprocal rights to Filipinos, Certification from the relevant government office of their country stating that Filipinos are allowed to participate in government procurement activities for the same item or product.
 9. Certification from the DTI if the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder.

10. Bid Security (if in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission).
 11. Section VI – Schedule of Requirements with signature of bidder's authorized representative.
 12. **Revised Section VII** – Specifications with response on compliance and signature of bidder's authorized representative.
 13. Duly notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) (sample form - Form No.6).

Note: During the opening of the first bid envelopes (Eligibility and Technical Component), only the above documents will be checked by the BAC if they are all present using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion to determine each bidder's compliance with the documents required to be submitted for eligibility and the technical requirements.

14. Duly filled-out **Revised Terms of Reference** signed in all pages by the authorized representative/s of the bidder.
15. Manufacturer's authorization (sample form - Form No. 9) or its equivalent document, confirming that the bidder is authorized to provide the brand being offered and consumables supplied by the manufacturer, including any warranty obligations and after sales support as may be required.
16. Manufacturer's certificate showing that the bidder is a Gold Level Partner of the brand being offered to ensure the level of expertise.
17. List of manufacturer's local sales and technical office in the Philippines with contact person, complete address, contact numbers and email address.
18. List of regional offices in the Philippines (preferably in Cebu and Davao) with contact person, complete address, contact numbers and email address.
19. Bidder's certification indicating its experience in configuring Multiprotocol Label Switching (MPLS) and Internet Protocol Virtual Private Network (IPVPN) connectivity.
20. List of at least two (2) installed base sites with MPLS and IPVPN implementation including company name, contact person and contact numbers and email address.
21. Escalation and support plan procedure.
22. List of certified local engineers with technical resume and valid/unexpired certification, to wit:
