- **Eligibility Documents – Class “A”**

#### Legal Eligibility Documents

1. Valid PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (Platinum Membership) (all pages);

#### Technical Eligibility Documents

2. Duly notarized Secretary's Certificate attesting that the signatory is the duly authorized representative of the prospective bidder, and granted full power and authority to do, execute and perform any and all acts necessary and/or to represent the prospective bidder in the bidding, if the prospective bidder is a corporation, partnership, cooperative, or joint venture or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder. (sample form - Form No. 7).
3. Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid, within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids. The statement shall include all information required in the sample form (Form No. 3).
4. Statement of the prospective bidder identifying its Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. The statement shall include all information required in the sample form (Form No. 4).

#### Financial Eligibility Documents

5. The prospective bidder's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission.

6. The prospective bidder's computation for its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) following the sample form (Form No. 5), or in the case of Procurement of Goods, a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NFCC computation.
- **Eligibility Documents – Class “B”**
7. Duly signed valid joint venture agreement (JVA), in case the joint venture is already in existence. In the absence of a JVA, duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful shall be included in the bid. Failure to enter into a joint venture in the event of a contract award shall be ground for the forfeiture of the bid security. Each partner of the joint venture shall submit its legal eligibility documents. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance, provided, that the partner responsible to submit the NFCC shall likewise submit the statement of all its ongoing contracts and Audited Financial Statements.
  8. For foreign bidders claiming by reason of their country's extension of reciprocal rights to Filipinos, Certification from the relevant government office of their country stating that Filipinos are allowed to participate in government procurement activities for the same item or product.
- **Technical Documents**
9. Certification from the DTI if the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder.
  10. Bid Security (if in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission).
  11. Section VI – Schedule of Requirements with signature of bidder's authorized representative.
  12. **Revised Section VII – Specifications with response on compliance and signature of bidder's authorized representative.**
  13. Duly notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) (sample form - Form No.6).

**Note: During the opening of the first bid envelopes (Eligibility and Technical Component), only the above documents will be checked by the BAC if they are all present using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion to determine each bidder's compliance with the documents required to be submitted for eligibility and the technical requirements.**

- **Other Documents to Support Compliance with Technical Specifications [must be submitted inside the first bid envelope (Eligibility and Technical Component)]**
  1. Notarized self-certification with reference to Securities and Exchange Commission showing at least five (5) years of existence in the IT Industry.
  2. Manufacturer's authorization (sample form - Form No. 9) or back to back certification confirming that the bidder is authorized to provide the subscription supplied by the principal, including any warranty obligations and after sales support as may be required.
  3. Certificate of Employment, Resume/Curriculum Vitae and list of seminars and trainings attended of at least two (2) certified local engineers, showing at least three (3) years work experience in handling the offered IT product or other related products and have at least one (1) year experience in handling email cloud security products.
  4. Certificate of Employment and resume/curriculum vitae of the dedicated Project Manager showing at least three (3) years work experience and handled at least one (1) Philippine Commercial or Universal Bank and one (1) non-bank client.
  5. Manufacturer's complete address, contact numbers and contact person.
  6. List of at least two (2) installed base in the Philippines of the same brand of Email Security Solution being offered, wherein one (1) is a Commercial or Universal Bank, with client name, contact person, complete address, contact number and email address.
  7. Escalation Procedure and Support Plan Flow Chart/Details.
- **Post-Qualification Documents/Requirements – [The bidder may submit the following documents/requirements within five (5) calendar days after receipt of Notice of Post-Qualification]:**
  1. Business Tax Returns per Revenue Regulations 3-2005 (BIR No.2550 Q) VAT or Percentage Tax Returns for the last two (2) quarters filed manually or through EFPS.
  2. Latest Income Tax Return filed manually or through EFPS.
  3. Original copy of Bid Security (if in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission).
  4. Original copy of duly notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) (sample form - Form No.6).

5. Duly notarized Secretary's Certificate designating the authorized signatory in the Contract Agreement if the same is other than the bidder's authorized signatory in the bidding (sample form – Form No. 7).

### Three (3) Years Subscription for Email Cloud Anti-Spam and Security Solution – Terms of References

**Objective:** To provide protection in the Bank cloud-based email mailboxes/users against spam that may clog up inboxes, spreads malware and viruses, phishing, and unsolicited product/promotions. To provide email-based security authentication requirements such as SPF, DKIM and DMARC.

	Technical Specifications	Comply?
<b>General Requirements</b>		
1	The email security system offering should be Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) offering to protect customers from email-based threats before they reach a user's mailbox.	
2	<b>The email security solution should be compatible and interoperable with LANDBANK's existing email security gateway. Compatibility and operability of the system shall mean minimal or no configuration change and no downtime due to MX record propagation.</b>	
3	The gateway should support a comprehensive email security solution defense against latest email threats such as Graymail Safe unsubscribing, snowshoe spam, viruses, Malicious URL Blocking, URL category-based filtering, Robust anti-APT, DNS RBL verification, reputation filtering and phishing filtering utilizing a strong global threat intelligence capability	
4	The solution should support 5,000 users for anti-spam, anti-virus, virus outbreak, Anti-APT, Graymail and File reputation. All features required from day one.	
5	Solution should have false positive efficacy of 1 in 1 million	
6	Proposed solution should have greater than 99% spam catch rate and should be a leader/Top Player in published email security gateway report	
7	Propose solution should not be software based and installed in mail server. It should be purpose built dedicated email security gateway.	
8	Proposed solution should support centralized reporting and message tracking.	
9	Proposed solution should support spam quarantine on centralized management system. Holds spam and suspected spam messages for end users and allow end users and administrators to review messages that are flagged as spam before making a final determination.	
10	The solution should support ability to perform SMTP session control and traffic rate limiting according to sender's IP address/range, domain, or email reputation. The solution should be able to assign maximum SMTP sessions per IP address.

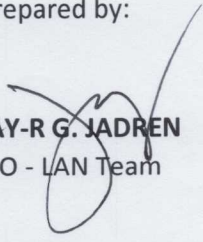

15	The solution shall ensure that the cloud solution is available (i.e., not experiencing a Service Outage) for 99.9% of the time during each calendar month.	
16	The solution must have a cloud service Point Of Presence (POPs) in Asia Pacific region for better performance and reliability.	
17	The solution must have a low-latency cloud access for a faster and responsive user access.

23	Solution should be able perform URL filtering on shortened URLs, and retrieve actual URL from shortened URL and perform action based on reputation score	
24	Solution should provide forged email detection protection against business executive compromise and provide detail logs on all attempts and actions.

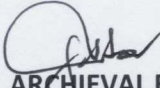

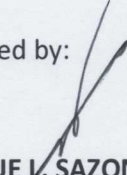
