This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend and/or clarify certain items in the Bid Documents. This shall form an integral part of the Bid Documents.

Modifications, amendments and/or clarifications:

- 1) The bidder/s are encouraged to use the Bid Securing Declaration as Bid Security.
- The Schedule of Requirements (Section VI) and Checklist of Bidding Documents (Item No.11 of Technical Documents) have been revised. Please see attached specific sections of the bidding documents.
- 3) Pre-termination/Termination of the Contract
 - Pre-termination/Termination of Contract shall be governed by the guidelines on Termination of Contracts per Annex "I" of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations
 - In addition to the grounds under the said Guidelines for Contract Termination the following are also grounds for pre-termination/termination:
 - Failure by the service provider to performs its obligation thereon;
 - Unsatisfactory Performance by the service provider within the contract duration
- 4) For Liquidated Damages: LANDBANK need not prove that it has incurred actual damages to be entitled to liquidated damages. Such amount shall be deducted from any money due or which may become due to Supplier. In case the total sum of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the total contract price, LANDBANK may rescind the contract and impose appropriate sanctions over and above the liquidated damages to be paid.
- 5) The bidder/s shall be guided by the following provisions in submitting the original bid security as applicable:
 - Section 27.1 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184
 - Section 9.2 of the Guidelines for Electronic Bidding (Appendix 3)
 - Section 6.1.4 of the Revised Guidelines on Electronic Bidding (Appendix 36)
- 6) Responses to bidder's gueries/clarifications per Annexes H-1 to H-2

- The Eligibility and Technical Component shall contain documents sequentially arranged as follows:
 - Eligibility Documents Class "A"

Legal Eligibility Documents

1. Valid PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (Platinum Membership) (all pages).

Technical Eligibility Documents

- 2. Duly notarized Secretary's Certificate attesting that the signatory is the duly authorized representative of the prospective bidder, and granted full power and authority to do, execute and perform any and all acts necessary and/or to represent the prospective bidder in the bidding, if the prospective bidder is a corporation, partnership, cooperative, or joint venture or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder. (sample form Form No. 7).
- 3. Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid, within the last five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids. The statement shall include all information required in the sample form (Form No. 3).
- 4. Statement of the prospective bidder identifying its Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents. The statement shall include all information required in the sample form (Form No. 4).

Financial Eligibility Documents

- 5. The prospective bidder's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission.
- 6. The prospective bidder's computation for its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) following the sample form (Form No. 5), or in the case of Procurement of Goods, a committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NFCC computation.

Eligibility Documents – Class "B"

- 7. Duly signed valid joint venture agreement (JVA), in case the joint venture is already in existence. In the absence of a JVA, duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful shall be included in the bid. Failure to enter into a joint venture in the event of a contract award shall be ground for the forfeiture of the bid security. Each partner of the joint venture shall submit its legal eligibility documents. The submission of technical and financial eligibility documents by any of the joint venture partners constitutes compliance, provided, that the partner responsible to submit the NFCC shall likewise submit the statement of all its ongoing contracts and Audited Financial Statements.
- 8. For foreign bidders claiming by reason of their country's extension of reciprocal rights to Filipinos, Certification from the relevant government office of their country stating that Filipinos are allowed to participate in government procurement activities for the same item or product.
- 9. Certification from the DTI if the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder.

Technical Documents

- 10. Bid Security (if in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission).
- 11. **Revised Section VI** Schedule of Requirements with signature of bidder's authorized representative.
- 12. Section VII Specifications with response on compliance and signature of bidder's authorized representative.
- 13. Duly notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) (sample form Form No.6).
- Note: During the opening of the first bid envelope (Eligibility and Technical Component) only the above mentioned documents will be checked by the BAC if they are all present using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion to determine each bidder's compliance with the documents required to be submitted for eligibility and the technical requirements.
- Other Documents to Support Compliance with Technical Specifications [must be submitted inside the first bid envelope (Eligibility and Technical Component)]
 - 14. Copy of Purchase Orders, Contracts or other related documents as proof of three (3) years minimum experience in the business of sales, design, installation and commissioning of Photovoltaic/Solar Panel System.
 - 15. List of at least five (5) different large institutional client (e.g. fast foods, BPOs, hospitals, funeral parlor, banks and government offices) with

- addresses, contact persons and telephone numbers including Certificate of Satisfactory Performance.
- 16. List of five (5) latest completed different large institutional clients/projects shall be accompanied by a Performance Assessment Report (PAR) for each project with at least a "Satisfactory" adjectival rating duly signed by the Owner and/or representative. The standard format for PAR shown in Annexes D-8 and D-9.
- 17. List of at least three (3) highly trained technicians (regular employees) with their respective Curriculum Vitae and Certificate of Employment.
- 18. Brochure or other official documents coming from the manufacturer showing the technical specifications of the product being offered.
- 19. Print-out of the specifications of the offered product posted in the manufacturer's website showing the URL (web address).
- 20. Certification from the following, whichever is available:
 - Bureau of Product Standards (PS)
 - Underwriters Laboratories (UL)
 - Conformance European (CE)
 - ISO Certification
- Post-Qualification Documents/Requirements [The bidder may submit the following documents/requirements within five (5) calendar days after receipt of Notice of Post-Qualification]:
 - 21. Business Tax Returns per Revenue Regulations 3-2005 (BIR No.2550 Q) VAT or Percentage Tax Returns for the last two (2) quarters filed manually or through EFPS.
 - 22. Latest Income Tax Return filed manually or through EFPS.
 - 23. Original copy of Bid Security (if in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission).
 - 24. Original copy of duly notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) (sample form Form No.6).
 - 25. Duly notarized Secretary's Certificate designating the authorized signatory in the Contract Agreement if the same is other than the bidder's authorized signatory in the bidding (sample form Form No. 7).
